

Nicolet Trail Campground Rules & Regulations

We would like to maintain a campground that all campers, including the surrounding community, can be proud of. To insure this, your cooperation is necessary. The rules and regulations stated below are for all campers to adhere to during the period of stay approved on your application permit. Violations to the rules and regulations listed below could result in the revocation of your permit and the eviction from the campground without a refund.

The Nicolet Trail Campground Rules & Regulations are as follows:

1. Your site must be kept clean and orderly.
2. Nothing will infringe onto a neighboring site (parked vehicles, stacks of wood, satellite dishes, etc).
3. There shall not be more than one unit allowed per site.
4. The number of people on your site cannot exceed the occupancy of the camper itself.
5. Only two vehicles are allowed per site and all recreational vehicles and cars must be parked on assigned sites. Additional parking and visitor parking is located in the city park.
6. Screen tents are permissible for eating purposes only and be no larger than 12'x12' in size.
7. Tents for sleeping are permissible providing there is a camper on the same site and the tent be no larger than 12'x12' in size.
8. Portable decks are allowed and be no larger than 12'x 6' in size.
9. Outdoor carpets and mats must be staked down with stakes no longer than 12 inches. All must be removed at the end of your camping period.
10. No stakes over 12" in length are allowed. You will be held responsible for any damage/cost incurred to underground utilities.
11. Satellite dishes are allowed only if attached to the trailer/camper or on a portable stand. Inground posts are not allowed.
12. All hoses, cords, wires, etc., will be run under the camper or carpets/mats for safety and ease of grass cutting.
13. You are responsible for the care and maintenance of your site by use of either your own personal push mower or one supplied by the campground. Riding mowers are not allowed.
14. Each site will consist of one picnic table and one firepit. Neither shall be moved off the site nor any moved in from another site.
15. DO NOT use charcoal grills on picnic tables or benches.
16. No trees will be cut, trimmed or damaged. Defacing, altering or damaging any campground property could result in a fine or even eviction from the campground.
17. Pets are allowed. No more than two pets per site. Pets must be on a leash at all times, no longer than 6ft in length. No pets will be left unattended outside. Pets must be cleaned up after immediately, day or night. Do not allow pets to dig holes. Damages must be repaired or fines will incur.

18. No noisy, intoxicated or disorderly persons or loud parties shall be allowed in the campground. Quiet hours must be observed from 10 P.M. to 7 A.M.
19. All firewood should be stacked in neat piles no more than 4' x 4' high.
20. All garbage must be put in clear plastic bags and be placed in the proper dumpsters provided. Recyclables must be separated and deposited into the proper recycling bins provided.
21. No outside refrigerators allowed.
22. No generators allowed.
23. No party lights will be left on or come on automatically if you are gone for more than two days at a time.
24. All drains on trailers/campers must be kept capped at all times. No discharge or dumping of grey water or sewage on ground is allowed.

AFFIDAVIT OF UNDERSTANDING

I have read, understood and will comply with all terms of the Nicolet Trail Campground rules and regulations. I understand if I violate ANY provision of these rules, I will be subject to fines at the discretion of the Campground Director with the possibility of the revocation of my permit WITHOUT REFUND. I also understand that I will be subject to a fee set forth by the Campground Committee for parking my trailer/camper on site before April 30th or remaining in the campground after October 31st, unless I have an approved permit for winter use and/or storage. I understand that the first half of the seasonal fee must be paid by or before May 1st and the second and final installment is due by or before June 30th or I can be EVICTED IMMEDIATELY. If payments are not made by the timeline given or if my permit is revoked and I am evicted from my site, I will be given 3 days to remove my camper/trailer and the site will be rented out to the next camper on the list. If the camper/trailer is not moved within the period specified, the City will impound it until fines/fees are paid. I am responsible for all occupants and guests of my site and subject to fees, fines or even eviction should they violate any of the rules and regulations listed. I will mail back this form, signed and dated as proof of my understanding and make a copy of the same to keep as my records.
